

Barbecue grill rules

Outdoor barbecue areas

Always follow the municipality's rules and safety guidelines around fires when barbecuing outdoors. It is your responsibility to check current rules and restrictions, e.g. open burning prohibitions.

- The barbecue areas are available for residents
- Keep water with you to extinguish fires
- Use only the association's casted fireplace or barbecues on a proper frame
- Single-use barbecues or barbecues placed directly on the ground are not allowed on the association's premises
- Do not light any fires or use barbecues if it is too windy
- Extinguish the fire and make sure that embers and smoulder is completely extinguished after you have finished
- Clean up after yourself and leave the area as you would like to find it next time
- Remove all waste and garbage
- Do not leave any food behind to avoid pests

If the fire spreads outside the fireplace or barbecue **CALL 112** to alert emergency services.

Barbecuing on the balcony

You are not allowed to barbecue on the balcony under any circumstances.
